Supervisor Smith explained the area and need for the no parking fire lane on Hotel Road off Hermitage Road on the South Shore of Lake Bonaparte. He put up a slideshow with pictures of the area for all present to view. Supervisor Smith informed all present that this fire lane is not being brought about to punish any residents living on this road. It was purely for safety reasons, in the event of an medical or fire emergency for fire trucks and ambulances to have access down this road. Councilman Malbeuf stated that the fire lane on the Hermitage Road was requested by lake residents living on that road. This brought up concerns that parking traffic would be pushed from Hermitage Road to Hotel Road, creating the same safety hazard. There was general talk of safety issues. The Board agreed that if residents are not happy with this, the Local Law could be revisited, adjusted, or rescinded. Supervisor Smith answered questions and then asked those in the audience if they were in favor. C.J. was not in favor and J.C. was not in favor.

Majority of those present were in favor of the No Parking/Fire Lane.

Supervisor Smith called for a motion to pass a Local Law for No Parking Fire Lane on Hotel Road off Hermitage Road on the South Shore of Lake Bonaparte.
